**“God’s Gift of Purpose for You”**

**WELCOME**

1. Consider your grandfather or grandmother for just a moment. How would you describe their purpose for living?
2. What is one purpose that God has given you that is yet to be completed? (Example: write a book, lead my friend to Christ, build a home for my family, etc.)

**WORSHIP**

Break up into pairs. Each person in the pair will pray *Ephesians 1: 4-5, 10* over his/her group member. Acknowledge God’s presence.

**WORD**

1. Pastor Rob described what savory salt and illuminating light meant to him. He defined this type of believer’s faith as committed, compassionate, costly and consistent. Who is savory salt and illuminating light to you? Who exemplifies these qualifiers of the faith to you?
2. Have the group turn to *Matthew 5:13-16*. What is the Holy Spirit saying to you?

4. What’s a person to do who is having trouble understanding his/her purpose?
