**We pray –**

**Suggested ways to pray –**

1. Begin your time with worship and repentance. We worship first, because the Lord is worthy of all of our adoration and praise! We spend time in confession and repentance according to Psalm 66: 17-19 "If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened; but God has surely listened and heard my voice in prayer. Praise be to God, who has not rejected my prayer or withheld his love for me!" We come to our Father in humility.
2. Pray with gratitude: Thank God that we live in a nation where we have the opportunity to have a voice in the way our government runs. Thank Him for the vote that you are able to cast. Thank God that regardless of the outcome in any

race, the Lord is still on His throne and in control! We need not be shaken, for we are stabilized in His love as we stay focused on Him. God is always with us, no matter the season.

3. Pray for a blanket of God's peace across our nation at every polling place. Pray for integrity and righteousness in the election process. Pray protection from any scheme of the enemy to influence the results of the elections or cause chaos or violence.
4. Pray for wisdom for voters, that all the saints would seek God's heart and will as they cast their ballot...and that God would move on the hearts of the lost to vote according to His kingdom will. Pray for God's chosen winners!
5. Pray for all candidates - the winners and the losers! That all would be blessed to come to the saving knowledge of our Lord Jesus.
6. Pray for God to heal our land, to bring unity according to His righteous paths. "Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, the people He chose for His inheritance." Psalm 33:12
